Obituary

Pastor Carsten Häublein (1957 -2013)

with excerpts from the speech at his memorial service

Pastor Carsten Häublein ended his own life on February 2013, after he suffered from unbearable symptoms, since the installation of LTE transmitters in July/2012, which broke his will to live.

Carsten Häublein was a minister and soulkeeper, in the service of his fellow man. During his ministry, he earned great distinction in the church districts Schrobenhausen, Ampfing and 14 years in Ammergau. He was able to share the Word of God in many ways with his fellow man.

For him, the Bible was his source of energy. With enthusiasm, he participated in The Passion Play, and hosted with his community, great numbers of American pilgrims.

He also visited Israel with his parishoners, to follow in the footsteps of Jesus.

Ecumenical Christianity was close to his heart. Through his efforts, the opening church services were celebrated in ecumenical harmony. Also, the gospel choir and many other achievements are the result of his intitiative.

His suffering began in 2006. With Pastor Häublein and many other residents, numerous unexplained and partially unbearable symptoms arose in the fall of 2006, after a celltower transmitter was changed in Oberammergau: extreme sleep disturbances, heart racing, blood pressure irregularities, headaches, inner vibrations, shaking, perspiration, burning, disorientation, inability to think clearly, exhaustion, hearing loss, ear pressure, eye infections, nerve pains, neuralgia (neurological pain).

It was a great blessing, that Pastor Häublein had the courage to make his sufferings public: "Heart racing, insomnia and night sweats."

"Pastor At His End" was the headline in the Munich newspaper, Merkur, on the 10.11.06.

This encouraged others who were affected, and also the doctors who treated them, to follow his example. Through close collaborations of Pastor Häublein , with professional engineer, Mr. Funk, local doctors and the community of Oberammergau, these considerable effects of low frequency modulated signals on human health, became known far beyond Oberammergau.

Despite lack of understanding and ridicule from various sides, he announced on the 30.01.07 in the Munich newspaper 'Merkur', that he has to leave Oberammergau, with the sentence: "Mobile communication has robbed me of my health!" With this sentence he questioned the validity of mobile communication technology.

In a live citizen forum on the Bavarian Television Network, in February 2007, it became clear, that many citizens suffer from this technology.

Despite of this, these increasing health issues were not investigated by government, nor science research.

The churches stayed silent, in the face of the human sufferings by Pastor Häublein, and the many who were affected and their doctors, dispaired.

In April 2009, after a long search, he was fortunate to find a place that was bearable for his health to

live. Within a few weeks he recovered and was full of energy, once again. He helped where he could, by telephone and by deed, others who were also affected, established contacts in other countries and again became the caregiver of souls.

Unfortunately this only lasted three years, before, even there, modern technology moved in.

In July 2012, from one day to the next, his health declined in the extreme. LTE, the fourth mobile phone generation for fast, wireless internet was activated.

In great dispair he discribed the most torturous symptoms: "I am perishing! Between the pounding in my head, and the inability to think clearly, inner vibrations, heart racing, shortness of breath, heating and burning all over my body, ear pressure and complete lack of motivation, I cannot go on any longer!"

Only under eight emergency silverfoil blankets and in water, he found some relief.

He hoped that further expansion of this technology would stop, and a radiation free zone would be made available for the severely affected.

But it was like in Oberammergau: the government agencies, politicians, telecom operators and scientists were not interested in the desperate people, who suffer from LTE. Now, even the media is staying silent, and day after day, more LTE-transmitters were installed.

Pastor Häublein could not see a way out, to be safe from this technology. He just wanted to escape the unbearable torture.

From the minister who held the eulogy at his memorial service:

"Now we have to say good-bye and ask ourselves, if we did everything we could to help our suffering fellow man. I do not know, if he in his life did not find open ears and helping hands, and I cannot exclude the church and their representatives. I would like to deliberately exclude the people, who stood by him in his difficult last period in his public service in Oberammergau.

We have to ask ourselves, if we are guilty of failing God and our deceased brother, and ask for forgiveness. The question regarding modern technology must be asked: should be done what is possible, even when people suffer because of this and perish. It is not just the individuals who appear as peculiar to some, but according to statistics, already 10% of our fellow man suffer from this not so innocent technology.

... it leaves the question open, how we treat our Earth, the creation of God, and how we deal with our fellow man, with the suffering and weak, the elderly and young, those who believe different than us, and those who look different.

It is mostly because of us, not God, when injustice and suffering is tolerated!"

It was his wish, that his gravestone would bear witness of the suffering that he had to endure.
